Orange County Philharmonic Society Scholarship Program

- * Ladislav Reday Memorial scholarship. Up to \$1,500 awarded to any Music major in any instrument.
- * David Lee Shanbrom Memorial Music Scholarship. Up to \$3,000 awarded to an outstanding Music student in any instrument.
- * Winifred W. Smith Music Scholarship. Up to \$2,500 awarded to a student with stringed instrument specialization.
- * Marcella Louise and Leonard Seiber Jones Music Scholarship. Up to \$1,250 awarded to an entering Music student.

Robert and Marjorie Rawlins Scholarship

- Up to \$5,000 annually
- Renewal of scholarship is contingent upon maintaining a 3.2 GPA and full-time status as a music major in residence at UCI.
